This one day, hands-on, in-person laboratory session will provide veterinarians with four (4) CE hours from some of the world leaders in equine embryo transfer. **Participants must complete the on-line Equine Embryo Transfer course prior to attending the laboratory session.** The on-line embryo transfer course **provides the necessary background lecture material to precede the in-person laboratory course**. Laboratory session is limited to 16 veterinarians.

The laboratory session will provide hands-on opportunities for embryo collection, washing, handling and manipulation (using bovine IVF generated embryos and microspheres) as well as non-surgical transfer techniques. Additional time will be dedicated to cryopreservation (vitrification) of embryos. This course is designed to provide veterinarians with knowledge and clinical skills to incorporate embryo transfer into their clinical practice.

Continuing education programs for veterinarians provided by Colorado State University are renowned for being practical and thorough with an innovative hands-on approach.
