



Anatomy Camp Leadership Award Application Requirements and Instructions

Purpose: The purpose of the Anatomy Camp Leadership Award is to broaden and cultivate the inclusive learning community at CSU's anatomy camp by recognizing and supporting need-based students with strong leadership skills that will contribute diverse ideas, interests, talents, and life experiences during their week at camp.

Award History: These funds are a result of the collaboration between past individuals that have been influenced by CSU Anatomy Camp. Former camp counselors, Biomedical Sciences faculty, and parents of campers from the previous three summers have donated money to extend the opportunity of attending camp to high school students across the country.

Award Amount: up to \$1,000

Eligibility Requirements: To be eligible for this award, students must meet the following requirements:

- Applicant must be a current high school sophomore, junior or senior
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.5
- Applicant must demonstrate leadership qualities
- Applicant must be active in extracurricular activities

Application Instructions: To have your application reviewed by our selection committee, please provide the following materials:

- Completed application
- Leadership project
- Short answers typed and submitted as a separate document
- Two letters of recommendation

- How has the applicant demonstrated leadership skills? How does the applicant work in group settings?
- Please give your assessment of the applicant's interpersonal skills.
